

ADVANCED RIFLE CAMP

Army West Point Rifle and Head Coach Web Wright III will host a weekend** Elite Rifle Camp for junior smallbore and air rifle shooters, 7-9 Aug., 2020! This will be an advanced level camp (NOT beginner marksmanship***) open to any and all highs school and junior high school (7th-12 grade) athletes to hone their skills and continue shooting at the NCAA collegiate level.

The camp will accommodate up to 20 smallbore and 20 air rifle athletes. Training will be split between classroom instruction and range drills, tailored to improving technical skills, competition strategies, confidence and general shooting knowledge – all critical to achieving elite status at the NCAA, national and international levels. Please choose the discipline in which you wish to participate.

The Camp Includes:

- 2 ½ days of shooting and instruction at the Tronsrue Marksmanship Center, the home of the Army West Point Rifle Team. Coaching staff will be comprised of Army Rifle coaching staff and a selection of other nationally recognized coaches and trainers.
- An overview of NCAA programs and what coaches are looking for in their athletes
- Dinner Friday evening, lunch for Saturday and Sunday
- Official Camp T-shirt and other merchandise
- Army West Point Rifle training journal
- ** Accommodation and transportation to the camp each day is the camper's responsibility. There are several reasonable hotel choices in the area. Each camper and guest will be required to provide certain administrative information to access this federal facility.
- *** Athletes are required to provide their own, ISSF/USA Shooting regulation equipment and firearms. This camp will follow the NCAA Rifle Smallbore 3 Position and 60 Shot standing air rifle discipline rules (not CMP 3P "Precision" or "Sporter" Air rifle shooting). Athletes are expected to have a fundamental grounding in firearms safety and ISSF/USA Shooting rules and regulations.
